2019 AYSO Region 13 Myles Standish Tournament Team Invitation



- Hello, Coaches! Region 13 is proud to invite your team to the 2019 AYSO Region 13 Myles Standish Tournament
- Scope:** AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections
- When:** Friday, Saturday & Sunday – November 29, 30 & December 1, 2019
- Where:** The tournament will be held at Victory Park, John Muir High School and Pasadena High School fields in Pasadena, California. There is no charge for parking. No pets are allowed at fields.
- Who:** AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players max, and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered to play in the AYSO 2019 primary season. Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per team).
- What:** Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed four games. Some teams will play an additional two games. All pool games will be 22-minute halves.
- Why:** The Myles Standish Tournament is being conducted as a fundraiser by Region 13 to raise funds for field development and maintenance.
- Awards:** All players will receive a tournament pin. There will be medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th place teams.
- Entry Fee, Refunds:** \$500 for U-14, \$475 for U-12, and \$450 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found.
- Referee Fee, Refunds:** \$300, refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified three-person referee team to cover up to four assigned games during the tournament.
- Rules:** A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.
- Acceptance:** The application deadline is November 1, 2019. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs. of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.
- How:** Teams will register using the online registration tool, found on the tournament page of the Region 13 website. Manual forms will be available on request only. Please send one Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees to the Tournament Director at the address below. Rosters should be emailed to td@ayso.org and must be signed by your Regional Commissioner. Please use the AYSO Team Tournament Roster generated by Blue Sombrero.
- Appropriate referee administrator must provide approval of referee team submitted via online team registration form. See referee form for details.
