

# Referees: What the card should look like when you get it from the coach:

Make sure this is completed so results can be tracked.

First and last names should be listed for coaches.

Unless a *properly trained and currently registered* assistant coach is listed, there is no assistant coach for the game.

**Game cards must be on card stock. If a coach offers a card on paper ask the coach to fill out a proper one if at all possible .**

Players must be listed by first and last name. All players on the team must be listed, whether or not they are at the game.

Players should be listed in numerical order by uniform. If they are not, *please remind the coach and if he has enough cards ask for a new one.* (This helps avoid delays during the game.)

Many referees like to write team colors here to help them avoid confusion during the game.

CIRCLE the rating and, for ratings other than 3, add notes.

MISCONDUCT: The referee must list all cautions and send-offs, noting the player's number, the time and the reason. All player send-offs and coach or spectator expulsions must be reported to the Regional Referee Administrator and a Referee Game Misconduct Report must be submitted.
